

## Terms and Conditions of the Gartoo logo design competition

1. This competition consists in a contest to design a logo for Gartoo. It is open to EU residents only.
2. You must be 18 years old or over on the closing date (see section 9 below) to enter this competition.
3. To enter the competition, design a logo to be used on the Gartoo website. Design an image which you think incorporates the design brief set out in section 11 below. Email your design to rahel [at] lokku.com
4. All designs must be submitted in svg format (preferably compatible with Inkscape ([www.inkscape.org](http://www.inkscape.org))) by email only.
5. By submitting a design to this competition, you are granting Lokku Ltd. a fully paid-up, sub-licensable, irrevocable, worldwide, exclusive licence until 1st of June 2010 (the "Term") to allow Lokku Ltd. to use all intellectual property rights ("IPRs") in and to your design for promotional use and for any other purpose. If you are selected as the winner (see section 10), following the Term, ownership of all intellectual property rights in and to your design will revert to you and you hereby grant Lokku Ltd., a fully paid-up, sub-licensable, irrevocable, worldwide, exclusive licence in perpetuity to allow Lokku Ltd. to use your design for any purpose. Please note that you will not receive any royalties if Lokku Ltd. uses your design. If you are not selected as a winner, ownership of all IPRs in and to your design will revert to you following the Term.
6. Entries must be entirely your own original work and must not breach any copyright or third party rights. Lokku Ltd. will not be made partially or fully liable for any non-original work submitted by you. All entries must be suitable for publication on the Gartoo website and public viewing. The design must not include any defamatory, offensive or unlawful content.
7. If you wish to enter this competition you must provide Lokku Ltd. with your full name, current residential address, telephone number and email address. Lokku Ltd. will only use your personal details for the purposes of administering this competition and, except your full name, will not publish them or provide them to anyone without your permission.
8. Only one entry will be accepted per person. Entries cannot be returned so remember to keep a copy.
9. The deadline for receiving entries for the competition by any route is 5pm on 1st of June 2009. Results will be announced on the Lokku Labs website on the 15th of June 2009. Lokku Ltd reserves the right to extend the competition deadline at its discretion. If there is a revision, the revised date will be published on the Lokku Labs website and the date for announcing the results will be postponed accordingly.
10. The winner will be selected by Lokku Ltd. in accordance with the criteria set out in section 11. Lokku Ltd.'s decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. All entries will be judged on the following criteria:  
A strong, imaginative design which:
  - is modern
  - is dynamic and conveys a feeling of movement or change
  - is simple and can be reproduced easily on print/online
12. The winner will be announced on the Lokku Labs website ([www.lokkulabs.com](http://www.lokkulabs.com)).
13. The winner will receive a prize consisting of a £100 travel voucher (or the same amount in a cheque) and a £150 nominal cheque. Lokku Ltd. will post the prize to the winner within 10 working days of announcing the winner.
14. The prize must be taken as stated and cannot be deferred or transferred.
